**III Baikal International scientific and practical conference
«Snow cover, atmospheric precipitation, aerosols: chemistry and climate»
March 23 – 27, 2020**

Third circular

The III Baikal International Scientific and Practical Conference "Snow cover, atmospheric precipitation, aerosols: chemistry and climate" will be held in Irkutsk, Listvyanka (lake Baikal), Russia on March 23-27, 2020. The conference is organized by Irkutsk National Research Technical University (<http://www.istu.edu/eng/>) and is supported by IUPAC (<https://iupac.org/event/snow-cover-atmospheric-precipitation-aerosols-chemistry-and-climate/>).

IUPAC endorsement implies that entry visas will be granted to all *bona fide* chemists provided application is made not less than six months in advance. If a visa is not granted two months before the meeting, the IUPAC Secretariat should be notified without delay by the applicant.

Conference will take place in Listvyanka (Lake Baikal).

The conference has an interdisciplinary nature and is devoted to the study of the chemistry of snow cover, precipitation, aerosols of the Earth at climate change. Main topics: observation, interpretation and modeling studies of the composition of snow cover, precipitation, aerosols and physico-chemical processes in Earth's atmosphere, including air pollution problems; the role of snow cover, precipitation, aerosols in biogeochemical cycles; chemical interaction of the oceans, the land surface and the biosphere with snow cover, precipitation, aerosols.

The purpose of the conference: the creation of a platform for the discussion of modern knowledge in the chemistry of snow cover, precipitation and aerosols under the influence of climate change; raising the level of information exchange, both within the scientific community and between organizations of the research sector and the commercial sector; expansion of methods and tools of scientific interaction and interdisciplinary information exchange; discussion of joint research in this field of science; to improve the quality of life.

Official languages of the conference: Russian, English.

Topics

1. Methods, methodology to the study of the physico-chemical properties and composition of the snow cover, precipitation, aerosols.
2. The impact of climate change, physico-chemical processes in the atmosphere and anthropogenic activity at the chemical composition of snow cover, precipitation, aerosols.
3. Modeling of the study of climate change, chemical composition and physico-chemical properties of the snow cover, precipitation and aerosols.
4. The role of the snow cover, precipitation, aerosols in biogeochemical cycles and the cryosphere.
5. The chemical interaction of the oceans, the land surface and the biosphere with snow cover, precipitation, aerosols.
6. Assessment of the impact of the snow cover, precipitation, aerosols on natural, socio-economic systems and human health.

Preliminary program in brief

1. Scientific program: reports of the participants, disputes, discussion of the results, and preparation of the resolution.

2. Scientific excursion program: FSBI "Zapovednoe Pribaikalye" (<https://baikal-1.ru/>); Baikal Astrophysical Observatory of the Institute of Solar and Terrestrial Physics of the SB RAS (<http://ru.iszf.irk.ru>); Baikal Museum of the Irkutsk Science Center of the SB RAS (<http://bm.isc.irk.ru/>); Meteorological station of the Irkutsk UGMS (<https://www.irmeteo.ru/>) in the village Listvyanka; Museum of the History of the Circum-Baikal Railway in the village of Port Baikal (<https://www.tripadvisor.ru>); Architectural and Ethnographic Museum "Taltsy" (<http://talci-irkutsk.ru/>).
3. Entertainment program: gala dinner and music program at the opening ceremony; gala dinner and music program at the closing ceremony.

Conditions of participation, the registration fee and the payment

All conference participants must register on the site (<http://snow-baikal.tw1.ru/index-eng>). When registering on the site (<http://snow-baikal.tw1.ru/index-eng>) the conference participant indicates the form of participation.

The size of the registration fee is \$600. The registration fee includes sending an invitation, participation in the scientific program of the Conference, participation in the scientific excursion program, participation in the entertainment program, coffee breaks, lunches, proceedings of the Conference, souvenirs, transfer from Irkutsk to Listvyanka and back, a general photo of the conference participants.

For participants from developing countries and young scientists (under 35 years), the registration fee is \$500. The registration fee includes: sending an invitation, participation in the scientific program of the Conference, participation in the scientific excursion program, participation in the entertainment program, coffee breaks, lunches, proceedings of the Conference, souvenirs, transfer from Irkutsk to Listvyanka and back, a general photo of the conference participants.

10% registration fee reduction for IUPAC Members, Affiliate Members, and Fellows is provided.

In-person conference participants may invite accompanying persons with them. Information on the number of accompanying persons and their data shall be indicated at registration (<http://snow-baikal.tw1.ru/register1-en>) or by e-mail.

The registration fee for accompanying persons is \$500. The registration fee includes sending invitations, participation in the scientific excursion program, participation in the entertainment program, coffee breaks, lunches, proceedings of the Conference, souvenirs, transfer from Irkutsk to Listvyanka and back, a general photo of the conference participants.

It is a condition of IUPAC endorsement that the principle of free circulation of scientists be applied. **IUPAC endorsement implies that entry visas will be granted to all *bona fide* chemists provided application is made not less than six months in advance. If a visa is not granted two months before the meeting, the IUPAC Secretariat should be notified without delay by the applicant.**

Proceedings of the Conference

The submitted materials will be published in the proceedings of the Conference “Snow cover, atmospheric precipitation, aerosols: chemistry and climate (March 23 – 27, 2020)” before beginning of the Conference.
